One of the sisters had to go to the bathroom just as the boxes were being distributed. By the time she got back, all the boxes were gone. When her twin sister opened her box, there were 2 pencils, 2 color boxes and two of everything in the box. Someone sure prayed for that box to go to just the right child!
